What we do

We have recycling bins for glass, aluminum, paper, and cardboard.
Recycled kitchen oils are used to produce soaps.

Solar power is used, contributing to 15% of the hotel's consumption.
We use thermal insulation in all buildings for energy saving.
There are green roofs in several buildings as a part of an extensive program.

Mechanical installation

All infrastructure is updated according to the highest thermal saving tools.

An extensive program of photovoltaic panels have been installed to cover more than 30% of the existing energy needs.
We save energy by using LED lamps.
A VRV-inverter system is used for the air-conditioning in all rooms and public areas for maximum energy saving efficiency.

Food management

All food and seasonal produce which is served in the hotel is sourced from a local supplier.
We have our own kitchen garden growing herbs, olives, seasonal fruits and vegetables which are all used in our restaurants and bars.
